# BIBLE READING PLAN Term 4 2019

## NBC YOUNG ADULTS

Reading the Bible is the most important spiritual practice you can do as a follower of Jesus, as it is one of the primary ways we connect, learn from and enjoy God. There are many helpful ways to read His word, what is important is that we read it!

This plan is designed to work alongside the teaching series at NBC throughout term 4 - The sermon series on Sunday night is on the 10 commandments in Exodus 20 and the Home Group studies journeys through Ephesians. There are also some other complementary readings. God can speak through his word in many ways and if you have a pattern that works for you then continue with that. If you're looking for something new though let us encourage you to adopt the following pattern as you spend time with God in his word.

#### PRAY - STOP - READ - STUDY - MEMORISE - PRAY

**Pray**: Start your time in prayer. There is no set thing that must be prayed. Come to God as you are, commit your time to him and ask him to speak to you through his word.

**Stop**: Quiet your mind from the distractions and thoughts, set your mind on God and posture yourself to be ready to listen to him. Try at first just sitting in silence for 1-2 minutes.

**Read**: Read the passages of that day. You will notice that sometimes there are repeated readings throughout a week, this is not a mistake. This is a practice to help you think deeply and slowly in God's word.

**Study**: Having read the passage, work through it again and study it. You may have a way you like to do that and if so, go for it. If not, or you would like to apply a different approach, try the COMA method:

(1) What's the <u>Context</u> (2) <u>Observe</u> what the passage is saying (3) What's the <u>Meaning</u> (4) How can you <u>Apply</u> it

**Memorise**: Each week memorise one small section from one of the passages of your choosing. It could be a couple of verses from a Psalm, a teaching from Jesus or whatever verse(s) that stand out to you. (Just remember the context of each verse to help prevent you using it incorrectly).

**Pray** (again): Pray whatever it is you've learnt, or God has put on your heart. A good idea is to turn what you've learnt and the passage itself into a prayer.

### Christmas reading plan

Throughout December, in the lead up to Christmas, we will be looking at the background and narrative of Jesus Birth. The Jews were expecting a Messiah for a long time, as the Old Testament (the scriptures) foretold that he would come. When Jesus was teaching the crowds and his disciples, he made the bold and true statement that all the scriptures pointed to him (John 5:39) and he was the fulfilment of them all (Luke 24:44). We can have great confidence that Jesus of Nazareth is that Messiah, the Son of God. But it is also good to remind ourselves, or perhaps learn for the first time, of some of the key passages which teach us that.

In the first two weeks of December, this plan will look at 10 key passages in the OT that are fulfilled by Jesus in the NT. The next two weeks we will look at the narrative of Jesus birth that we find in the Gospels. Having seen Jesus fulfilling the Old Testament and reading his birth, hopefully we will be able to rejoice with Philip and say "we have found the one Moses wrote about in the Law, and about whom the prophets also wrote – Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." (John 1:45).
